

DRAWINGS OF MOON OF THE COUNT L. F. MARSIGLI FROM 1696 AND THEIR SCIENTIFIC SIGNIFICANCE FOR THE END OF XVII AND THE BEGINNING OF XVIII CENTURY

Here are shown 16 drawings of Moon, old from 4 to 24 days, made during the observations on the territory around Danube and Tisa on locations from Vienna to Titel. Observations were made by Marsigli Luigi Ferdinand (1658-1730) and published in 1726. Also, scientific significance of these drawings for the end of XVII and the beginning of XVIII century was analyzed.
